Termination of Long Term Disability Insurance

Reminder

Effective September 1, 2001, you may qualify to cancel your long term disability (LTD) insurance if you meet one of the following criteria as set out by your insurance policy.

Your LTD insurance terminates on the earliest of the following dates:

- 1) The end of the month following your 65th birthday, less the length of the waiting period*
- 2) The date you qualify for a 66% unreduced service pension less the length of the waiting period*
- 3) The date you achieve the 85 factor and have sufficient sick leave credit accumulation to cover you until retirement. You must be in your last year of teaching.

* The waiting period for your LTD plan is 60 working days or expiration of sick leave to a maximum of 200 working days.

Based on the criteria listed above, if you qualify to cancel your coverage please complete the form on the back of this page.

You must attach a copy of your most recent Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan Statement and a sick leave accumulation statement from the board. Please submit your completed form with the necessary documentation at least 2 months prior to ensure the board stops deducting LTD premiums on time.
