Pension survey results released

A just-released report on member contribution and benefit preferences shows:

- High member awareness of key pension provisions, such as the 85 factor.
- Most members would support an average maximum contribution rate of 12.3% of earnings to preserve all pension provisions.
- Most members would support making pension cost-of-living increases conditional on the financial well-being of the plan, if required to keep contributions from rising above 12.3%.

The results are not binding, but give the OTF and the Ontario government information to consider if a funding shortfall must be addressed in the future.
